## Programs & Events

### Sports

#### Annual Pumpkin Run

MUST has brought back a Manteca tradition by hosting the Annual Pumpkin Run, which will be held in conjunction with the Manteca Pumpkin Fair. Started in 1979 with the support of the Manteca High School Associated Student Body, the Pumpkin Run enjoyed over 700 participants in its heyday. MUST hopes to re-ignite the interest in the Pumpkin Run and in community support for student sports programs.



#### MUST 4<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> Sports Programs

MUST has partnered with Manteca Unified and is supporting an interscholastic sports league at all of the elementary schools. Sports planned for the 2007-2008 include Basketball, Cross Country, Track and Field, Volleyball. Students in grades 4-8 can participate in Cross Country and Track and students in grades 7-8 are invited to participate in Volleyball, and Basketball. While students pay a small fee to participate in this program the fees collected at the gate and through sponsorships offset more than 50% of the cost of this program. ### Science and Art

#### Stuck on Science

Stuck on Science is the annual fundraiser focusing on raising funds to support all 5<sup>th</sup> grade students attending Science Camp. The fundraising activities include a raffle for giant resin cast banana slug yard decorations decorated by District high school students. Tickets can be purchased from any fourth grader for \$1.00 each. The slugs are raffled at the Suck on Science dinner which includes great food, and a visit from some mad scientists. 100% of the money donated to stuck on science goes directly to student fees for science camp and many local foundations and sponsors have donated directly to this campaign. Students start fundraising in 4<sup>th</sup> grade to help cover the costs of their 5<sup>th</sup> grade trip.



#### District Art Contest

MUST partners with MUSD to host the annual District Art Show and Sale. Two and three dimensional art created by students, employees and local artists is highlighted in the annual event held in the Spring at the District Office. This year a school level contest will be held as each High School competes to create the best "living book" for display at the new District Office. Students who enter work in the District Art Show have the option of selling their art in a silent auction. Music and culinary delicacies also created by MUSD high school students support making this a best of the best event.

### School Farm and Scholarships

#### District Farm

This year MUST has joined efforts with the MUSD District Ag Advisory Committee and is looking for fiscal support to upgrade the facilities at the school farm. Plans currently include new barns, show rings, observer stands, and expanded crop production areas. Events this year will include the 2<sup>nd</sup> annual corn maze, pre-show exhibition day and fresh produce sales.

#### Scholarships

This year MUST will award scholarships to students at each of our comprehensive high schools.
